Introduction

Key Scriptures for Reflection

1. Integrity:

- Proverbs 10:9 "Whoever walks in integrity walks securely, but he who makes his ways crooked will be found out."
- 1 Samuel 12:3 "Here I stand. Testify against me in the presence of the Lord and his anointed."

2. Accountability:

- Proverbs 27:17 "As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another."
- James 5:16 "Therefore confess your sins to one another and pray for one another."

Accuracy:

- Jeremiah 1:12 "The Lord said to me, 'You have seen correctly, for I am watching to see that my word is fulfilled.""
- Deuteronomy 18:18-22 "How can we know when a message has not been spoken by the Lord?"

4. Community:

- Acts 13:1-3 "While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul."
- 1 Corinthians 14:29 "Two or three prophets should speak, and the others should weigh carefully what is said."

Lesson Points

1. Integrity in Prophetic Ministry

- Be honest when you miss it and seek reconciliation.

2. Accountability Structures

Submit your prophetic words to trusted leaders.

- Partner with mentors or seasoned prophets for guidance.

- Study Scripture to ensure prophetic alignment.
- Wait on the Lord in prayer before sharing.
- o Practice delivering prophetic words in safe settings for growth.

- Engage in a local church or prophetic group.
- Share your gift in a team environment.
- Allow others to confirm and interpret prophetic words.

Questions for Personal Reflection

- 1. Integrity:
 - Am I walking in a way that honors God publicly and privately?
 - o Do I remain truthful even when it's uncomfortable?
- 2. Accountability:
 - Who are the mentors or leaders I've submitted my gift to?
 - How open am I to correction and guidance?
- 3. Accuracy:
 - Does what I'm sensing align with Scripture?
 - Have I prayed and sought clarity before releasing a word?
- 4. Community:
 - Am I actively engaged in a local church or prophetic group?
 - How am I contributing to the growth and health of my spiritual community?

Best Practices for Prophetic Ministry

1. Regular Prayer and Bible Study

- Stay grounded in the Word of God.
- Develop intimacy with the Holy Spirit.

2. Submit Words for Testing

Allow leaders to weigh and confirm your prophetic words.

3. Build Trust

Honor commitments and remain dependable.

4. Use Wisdom in Delivery

- o Avoid emotionally charged or vague language.
- Share words in love, not judgment.

5. Be Spirit-Led, Not Performance-Driven

o Don't feel pressured to perform; prioritize obedience.

Devotional Plan (7 Days)

Day 1: Integrity — Proverbs 10:9

- Prayer: Ask God to help you walk blamelessly in your prophetic call.
- Reflection: Journal areas where you need to grow in integrity.

Day 2: Accountability — James 5:16

- Prayer: Thank God for people who sharpen and guide you.
- Reflection: List the mentors you can reach out to this week.

Day 3: Accuracy — Jeremiah 1:12

- Prayer: Ask the Lord to help you hear and see clearly.
- Reflection: Write down what you're sensing prophetically.

Day 4: Community — 1 Corinthians 14:29

- Prayer: Pray for unity and discernment in your church.
- Reflection: Who can help you weigh prophetic words?

Day 5: Humility — Philippians 2:3

- Prayer: Ask God to remove pride from your heart.
- Reflection: Reflect on how humility shapes your gift.

Day 6: Stewardship — 1 Peter 4:10

- Prayer: Thank God for entrusting you with His gifts.
- Reflection: How are you stewarding the prophetic?

Day 7: Boldness — 2 Timothy 1:7

- Prayer: Pray for boldness to step out in faith.
- Reflection: Write down one step of obedience you can take today.
